Performance

Mechanical and physical testing can measure the fit for purpose of your textiles.

- · Targeted end use dependent testing
- Durability testing
- · Washing performance

Comfort

Objective measures for comfort can now take the guess work as to whether, active wear, work wear or even casual clothing offer the desired levels of comfort.

- The Sweating Guarded Hotplate apparatus ("skin model") measures, according to ISO 11092, the ability of a textile to insulate and move water vapour away from the skin
- AWTA Ltd has developed the Wool ComfortMeter and Wool HandleMeter
- The Wool Comfortmeter counts the number of fibres protruding from fabric that cause wearer discomfort or "prickle"
- The Wool HandleMeter overcomes the subjective judgement traditionally associated with a fabric's "handle" or its smoothness, softness, dry feel, tightness and perceived weight

Colour

Whether developing colour palettes, maintaining colour continuity or measuring colour fastness, effective colour management is key for all apparel and interior textiles.

- Visual or digital ratings using modern spectrophotometers accurately place your shade where it belongs in the colour space
- Ensure suitable colour fastness to the elements, washing, and during use by testing these properties
